

Policies & Procedures Shiloh Community Center

- * Smoking, chewing tobacco, and alcohol are prohibited in the S.C.C. or on the Shiloh Community Church grounds.
- * Liability - The user of the S.C.C. will keep and hold Shiloh Community Church harmless from any and all damages, costs and expenses in connection with any and all claims, actions or causes of actions for injury, death or property damage arising from or out of the use and occupancy of the facility.
- * Attire - Shirts and shoes are required in all areas. Only non-marking gym shoes are permitted in the gym.
- * Personal Conduct - All guests are expected to conduct themselves in a mature, responsible manner when using the facility. Abusive language or fighting will not be tolerated and will result in suspension or termination of facility privileges.
- * Weapons - Firearms, knives, BB guns, air soft guns, slingshots and all other dangerous weapons are strictly prohibited.
- * All children, 6 years and younger (including 1st grade), must be accompanied by an adult. Second and Third grade students may attend activities without an adult but must be signed in and out by an adult. Students 4th grade and up may attend activities without an adult but must sign in at the front desk. The S.C.C. staff is not responsible for children/students once they have signed out of the S.C.C. for the day.
- * All participants in the S.C.C. Summer Programs must fill out a registration form and a medical and liability release form before participating in any activity. Minors must have forms signed by their parent or legal guardian.
- * Open Gyms - Please note that open gyms are designated for specific age groups. Please check the schedule for days, times, and age groups.
